In the forward to Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions, co-founder Bill W. wrote "A.A.'s Twelve Steps are a group of principles, spiritual in nature, which, if practiced as a way of life, can expel the obsession to drink and enable the sufferer to become happily and usefully whole." Some have, perhaps naturally, inferred from this that somewhere in A.A. literature there exists a list of principles. However, as said above, there is no single list that exists in A.A.W.S.-published literature.
